La sua collaborazione con SDA Bocconi ha inizio nel 2002. È stata prima Coordinatrice e poi Direttrice del Master in International Health Care Management, Economics and Policy dal 2012 al 2015 (MIHMEP). Ha ottenuto diversi finanziamenti per la ricerca e ha coordinato importanti progetti di ricerca finanziati dalla Commissione Europea e da agenzie donatrici internazionali. Dal 2017 al 2022, è stata Direttrice del Centro di Ricerche sulla Gestione dell'Assistenza Sanitaria e Sociale (CERGAS).

Dal 2022 copre la prestigiosa carica del Presidente-Eletto dell'Associazione Europea di Economia della Salute (EuHEA), mentre nel periodo 2021-2013 è stata la Presidentessa dell'Associazione Italiana di Economia Sanitaria (AIES). Nel periodo 2021-2022 ha ricoperto il ruolo del Consulente Speciale (Special Advisor) del Presidente della Commissione Pan-Europea sulla Salute e lo Sviluppo Sostenibile fondata dall'Organizzazione Mondiale della Sanità.

Al centro delle ricerche della Prof.ssa Torbica si trova la complessa interazione tra politiche sanitarie globali, economia della salute e management sanitario. Le sue indagini sono guidate dall'ambizione di districare le complessità dei processi decisionali nel campo sanitario ai diversi livelli. Le sue attività di ricerca ricoprono diverse aree disciplinari: economia della salute, politica sanitaria, salute globale, sistemi di finanziamento in sanità, health technology assessment, governance dei sistemi sanitari.
